

Repeat Monitoring Violation (TCR 25/26)

Each month, Brazos Valley Spring Water, LP (PWS# 1840161) is required to submit water samples for bacteriological testing. The samples we submitted during October, 2010 contained coliform bacteria. The presence of coliform bacteria indicates a potential problem with our water treatment system or the pipes that distribute the treated water.

When coliform bacteria are found in a routine sample, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requires us to collect a specific number of repeat samples to help determine if there is a problem.

We did not collect the correct number of repeat samples.
